Supervisor Gasperich informed the Board that he applied for a \$20,000 grant from The Portage Health Foundation for the Calumet Township Recreational Park and it was approved.

Supervisor Gasperich reported that the logging near Calumet Lake is almost finished. Motion by Treasurer Mattson and supported by Trustee Yeo to continue logging Red Pine and European Larch near the old dump. Carried 6 0.
