Pen Gas Building: Heikkila updated the board on current status of building. Laurium DPW has moved into the building after their fire. It was agreed that a lease agreement would be drafted and insurance be straightened out to allow Laurium to use the building.

Heikkila will solicit quotes for a new Mini Excavator to present to the board.
